<b>Application Fee</b> (Non-refundable)	500	To be paid at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable. Re-entries and re-applicants are also obliged to pay this fee.
<b>Registration Fee</b> (Non-refundable)	55,000 50,000	For parents registering their first child in the school. For parents already having a child in the school
<b>Deposit</b> (Refundable)	81,320	All Non–Mauritian students entering the school will be required to pay a deposit amounting to one term's tuition fees. This deposit is refundable on the child's departure on condition that one term's notice is given, in writing, prior to departure.

<b>Annual Capital Fee</b> (Non refundable)	7,500	The Annual Capital Fee is used to finance infrastructure development of the school.

<b>Books / Materials / Electronic Media</b>	4,400	Materials provided by the school.

<b>Parents Association (PA) Membership Fees</b> (optional)	500	One time only payment  The IPS Parent Association (PA) is a separate body from the IPSA. The difference being that the PA assists the school on a day to day basis by, for example, selling school materials and uniforms, organising fund raising events and after school activities for the students.
<b>IPS Association (IPSA) Membership Fee</b> (optional)	500 500	Joining fee Annual fee  Being a member of the IPSA allows you to become involved in the school community and actively participate in the development of the school. The IPSA assists the school in future and strategic planning initiatives. As an IPSA member you are also entitled to stand for election to the Board of Governors.



## CONDITIONS

1. IPS provides a limited accident coverage for students and disclaims any financial responsibility for sickness or accident/injury sustained by a student on the IPS campus or at any IPS sponsored outing or function
2. Fees are to be paid in 11 equal monthly instalments and must be paid in full on or before the first day of July to receive a 3% discount. If paying by instalment – this must be by **standing order** and you are required to ensure the payment is made on the first working day of each month. No child will be admitted to a class until the Bursar indicates all initial payments and documents have been completed.
3. Any tuition payments that are past due will result in the student being suspended from school until all outstanding fees have been settled.
4. All books are the property of the school. The cost of any damaged or lost books will be charged to the parents.
5. The full school fees, as invoiced, will be due and payable to IPS regardless of the number of days a student attends school.
6. If you wish to withdraw your child from the school, for any reason whatsoever, you shall provide the school with one terms (4 months) notice of withdrawal, in writing. Failure to do so will result in the Deposit not being refunded to you.
